EGG CUP PLACE CARDS



You'll need:

greeting card (especially ones with springtime designs)

scissors

ruler


colored markers

white glue

paper clips

STEP 1

For the front of the egg cup, choose a springtime design printed on the front of your greeting card (flowers or bunnies look perfect); designs that measure a few inches across work best. Cut your design from the card. Use diagram below for template.



STEP 2

Cut a strip measuring 6" long and 1" wide from the leftover part of the card. Glue the strip into a ring with an overlap of about 1" (use a paper clip to hold it together while the glue dries).

STEP 3

Cut a strip about 2" long by 3/4" wide from an unused part of the card (be creative with your shaping, if you like). Use your markers to write a name on the place card.

STEP 4

Glue your design onto the ring (make sure the bottom edges of the two pieces are even so your egg cup will sit flat when an egg is in it). Glue a name card on the center of the design.
